This box includes isolation switches, circuit breakers, and leakage protectors to ensure direct control and protection of the connected equipment. Key Features Hierarchical Protection: The system often employs a two-level or three-level protection approach, with residual current devices (RCDs) installed at both secondary and tertiary levels to prevent electrical hazards. Safety Principle: Follows the principle of "one machine, one switch, one RCD, one box, one lock," ensuring that each switch controls only one device or circuit. Application: Commonly used in construction sites, residential complexes, and industrial facilities to manage power distribution efficiently and safely.
