- Pulley or stringing blocks:** Guide cable along the route.
- Cable pulling grips and winches:** Facilitate controlled cable pulling.
- Safety equipment:** Helmets, gloves, high-visibility vests, safety harnesses, and insulated tools.
- Testing equipment:** OTDR and power meters for post-installation verification.
