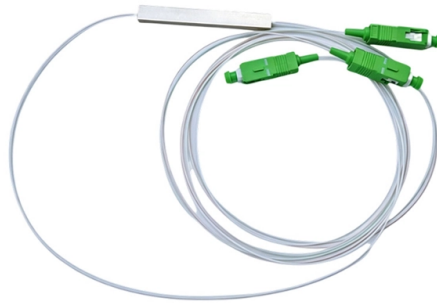

7. **Reassemble and Restore Power:** Once all connections are secure and verified, reassemble the box cover and restore power at the main breaker.
