Wire the Power Board: Run the wiring from the new breaker to the power board or outlet. Ensure proper wire gauge, insulation, and secure connections to prevent overheating or faults ().

Check Compliance: Follow local electrical codes (NEC, IEC, or regional standards) and use certified components (UL/CE) to ensure safety and compliance ().
