Load Ratings and Support Spacing

- Support Spacing:** Typically 1.5–3 meters for ladder and ventilated trays; shorter spans for heavy cables or long runs.
- Load Capacity:** Depends on tray width, material, and rung spacing. Standard tables from manufacturers (ABB, Eaton, Legrand) provide maximum uniformly distributed load (UDL) for each tray type and size.
- Bend Radius:** Maintain minimum bend radius for cables exiting trays to prevent damage; usually 6–12 times cable diameter.
