It is widely used in FTTx networks and environments where future network expansion is anticipated, as it minimizes splicing and interconnection points, enhancing system performance and reducing optical loss.

Key Accessories

- 1. Microducts and MicroCables** Microducts are small conduits designed to house fiber cables, available in HDPE, PVC, and PVDF materials for indoor and outdoor use. MicroCables range from 6 to 432 fibers, with reduced diameter sheaths to fit inside microducts. Bundled microducts, such as FuturePath, allow multiple ducts in one structure for future expansion.
- 2. Couplers and End Caps** Couplers connect microduct sections, ensuring a continuous path for fiber installation. End caps protect duct ends from debris and environmental exposure during installation.
- 3. Cable Jetting Equipment** Cable Jetters enable both air-blown and mechanical pushing of fiber cables, supporting diameters up to 3mm and lengths up to 250 feet. Kits often include a portable compressor (typically 80–90 PSI), nylon pull strings, and accessories to aid in cable movement past bends.
- 4. Specialty Fittings and Accessories** Accessories include splice kits, cutters, and Bull-Line pull tape to assist in cable and conduit installation. Specialty conduits may be aerial, locatable, fire-resistant, or mechanically reinforced to meet specific project requirements.
- 5. Installation Support Tools** Tools for cleaning, lubricating, and guiding fiber through ducts are essential for maintaining cable integrity and ensuring smooth installation...
