Algeria is rapidly expanding its fiber optic network to support smart buildings, FTTH connectivity, and high-speed digital services, with over 200,000 km of fiber deployed nationwide. Fiber Optic Network Expansion Algeria has made significant strides in digital infrastructure, completing a 2,600 km segment of the Trans-Saharan Fiber Optic Backbone, connecting Algeria with Niger, Nigeria, Chad, Mali, and Mauritania. This project enhances regional connectivity, supports e-commerce, online financial services, and strengthens broadband access across the country, contributing to the development of a digital economy (WeAreTech Africa, 2024). Domestically, Algeria has deployed over 200,000 km of fiber optic cable, covering all 58 wilayas, with new connections averaging 100,000 per month. The government has committed to a complete copper network phase-out by 2027, ensuring that fiber becomes the primary medium for high-speed internet and smart infrastructure (LinkedIn, 2026).

FTTH and Smart Building Connectivity Algeria Telecom, in partnership with FiberHome, is implementing FTTx and GPON/XGSPON solutions to provide fiber-to-the-home (FTTH) connectivity. By the end of 2023, over 1.08 million households were connected, with speeds up to 1.6 Gbps for residential users and 10 Gbps symmetric capability for higher-tier plans, enabling smart building applications such as IoT, cloud services, and energy management systems (FiberHome, 2024; LinkedIn, 2026). The FTTH generalization program ensures that optical fiber runs end-to-end from the connection node to subscribers, providing low latency, high reliability, and immunity to electromagnetic interference, which is critical for smart building automation and digital services (MeaTechWatch, 2024).
