

Assembly of power distribution equipment and distribution boxes in Bhutan



AI Overview

In Bhutan, power distribution equipment and distribution boxes are assembled using standardized prefabricated substations and locally manufactured components to ensure safe, reliable, and efficient electricity delivery. Types of Distribution Equipment Bhutan utilizes a range of power distribution equipment, including high-voltage switchgear, distribution transformers, low-voltage switchgear, energy metering devices, and power factor compensation devices. These components are often integrated into ZBW-type prefabricated substations, which are modular units designed for rapid installation and deployment in urban, industrial, and residential areas. The equipment is rated for 10/0.4 kV networks with a frequency of 50 Hz, and transformer capacities range from 50 kVA to 1600 kVA. Assembly and Installation Prefabricated substations are assembled in a controlled environment and delivered as complete units or in modular boxes according to specific wiring schemes. Key assembly features include: Base frame: Welded channel steel for high strength and rigidity. Enclosure: Composite materials with strong radiation resistance to reduce heat absorption. Compact design: Small floor area, short installation cycle, and deep integration into load centers. Safety and reliability: IP23D protection level, suitable for environments without fire, explosion, or severe chemical pollution. Installation requires consideration of environmental conditions, including altitude ≤ 1000 m, ambient temperature $-25 \sim 40^{\circ}\text{C}$, relative humidity $\leq 90\%$, wind speed ≤ 34 m/s, and ice thickness ≤ 20 mm.
