

Broadband Aggregation Switch Settings



AI Overview

Configuring a broadband aggregation switch involves creating link aggregation groups (LAGs), assigning VLANs, and optionally enabling LACP for dynamic link management to increase bandwidth and reliability.

Step 1: Access the Switch Connect to the switch via console, SSH, or Telnet using administrative credentials. Enter privileged mode (e.g., enable on Cisco) and then configuration mode (configure terminal) to make changes.

Step 2: Plan Link Aggregation Identify the physical ports to be aggregated. Decide whether to use static aggregation (manual) or dynamic aggregation with LACP (IEEE 802.3ad) for automatic negotiation. Ensure all member ports have the same speed, duplex, and flow control settings.

Step 3: Configure Link Aggregation

For LACP (dynamic aggregation): Assign ports to a LAG group and set the mode to Active on both ends. Example for TP-Link: Go to Switching → LAG → LACP Config, select ports, assign an Admin Key, enable the group, and apply settings. For static/manual aggregation: Create an Eth-Trunk or aggregate interface and add member ports. Ensure the remote device mirrors the configuration for proper communication. Cisco CLI example:

```
CodeCopy
interface range
GigabitEthernet1/0/21-22
channel-group 1 mode active
Configure the aggregated interface as a VLAN member or trunk depending on your network design.
```

Step 4: VLAN and Trunk Configuration Assign the aggregated interface to the required VLANs for Layer 2 traffic segregation. If multiple VLANs are needed, configure the interface as a trunk and allow the necessary VLANs:

```
CodeCopy
interface Port-channel1
switchport mode trunk
switchport trunk allowed vlan 10,20
Verify VLAN connectivity between switches to ensure proper inter-VLAN communication.
```

Step 5: Verification and Best Practices Check the status of the LAG or Eth-Trunk to confirm all member ports are active. Use commands like show etherchannel summary (Cisco) or equivalent on other vendors. Avoid connecting multiple physical links without aggre...
