They help separate copper and fiber cables and maintain proper bend radius .Brush Panels – Used at cable entry and exit points to reduce dust intrusion and provide strain relief for cables crossing different U-levels .Cable Trays and Ladders – Support overhead or underfloor routing, especially in larger installations, ensuring secure pathways and preventing tangling .Best Practices for Implementation Plan the Layout: Evaluate current and future equipment needs, including servers, switches, storage, and cabling volume. Leave 30% extra U-space for expansion and verify rack depth for modern PoE++ switches .Separate Power and Data Cables: Avoid interference by routing power and data lines separately .Maintain Proper Bend Radius: Follow manufacturer specifications to prevent signal degradation, typically four times the cable diameter for Cat6A and stricter for fiber .Use Color-Coded and Labeled Cables...
