Ventilated Trough/Channel Tray: Solid or partially perforated bottom; used for medium-weight cables and applications requiring some protection from dust or electromagnetic interference. Solid Bottom Tray: Fully enclosed; suitable for sensitive instrumentation and control cables where protection from environmental factors is critical. Wire Mesh Tray: Lightweight, welded steel mesh; used for light cabling, easy to install, and adaptable to complex routing. Material and Environmental Classification Cable trays are manufactured from various materials, each with specific environmental and mechanical properties: Steel: Pre-galvanized or hot-dip galvanized for corrosion resistance; suitable for industrial and outdoor environments. Stainless Steel (AISI 316L): High corrosion resistance, especially in marine or chemical environments. Aluminum: Lightweight, corrosion-resistant, suitable for indoor and outdoor applications. Fiberglass/Nonmetallic: UL 568 compliant; resistant to corrosion and chemical exposure, used in specialized industrial settings.
