 - Tray Supports:** Verify that supports, hangers, and couplers are secure and free from corrosion.
- Cable and Tray Protection**
 - Covers and Seals:** Check tray covers for proper installation to prevent dust, water ingress, and mechanical impact. Ensure IP ratings are met in hazardous or outdoor areas.
 - Bends and Transitions:** Inspect bends and transitions for smoothness to prevent cable stress. Deburr sharp edges and apply protective coatings if necessary.
 - Segregation:** Ensure separation of power, control, and signal cables to minimize electromagnetic interference (EMI). Use dividers or separate trays for intrinsic safety (IS) cables.
- Grounding and Bonding**
 - Bonding Jumpers:** Inspect bonding jumpers between tray sections and confirm connection to the grounding system.
 - Continuity Testing:** Conduct electrical continuity tests to ensure proper earthing and compliance with grounding requirements.
- Fire and Corrosion Protection**
 - Fire-Rated Sealants:** Apply sealants at tray penetrations through firewalls...
