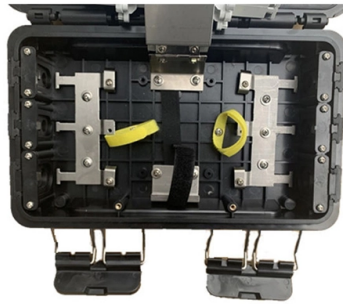

Cable selection for distribution boxes depends on voltage level, current rating, insulation type, and installation environment, with LV distribution boxes typically using copper or aluminum conductors with heat-resistant insulation and proper phase color coding.

Low-Voltage (LV) Distribution Boxes

Incoming and outgoing feeders: LV distribution boxes generally use copper flat or stranded conductors, sized according to the load and short-circuit current. For example, copper flat bus bars of 25x4 mm are commonly used for phase connections, with heat-shrinkable or color-coded insulation tubing (Red, Yellow, Blue for phases, Black for neutral) to ensure safety and phase identification.

Cable type: Flexible rubber cables such as H07RN-F are suitable for industrial LV applications, offering mechanical strength, chemical and oil resistance, UV resistance, and water submersion capability. These cables are rated for up to 1000 V, with a maximum conductor temperature of 90°C and short-circuit temperature of 250°C for 5 seconds.

Protection and installation: LV boxes include MCCBs for overcurrent protection, with metallic or heat-resistant insulating barriers between breakers. Cable glands are heavy-duty, double compression brass, with separate glands for incoming and outgoing cables. Minimum bending radius is 3x cable diameter for
