Compliance and Standards Fixing brackets and cable trays must comply with IEC 61537 for metal cable tray systems or BS EN 61537 in the UK. This ensures compatibility, safety, and performance under expected loads. Brackets should be part of a tested system, as using mismatched components can compromise safety. Fire-resistant materials are required to prevent premature failure in case of fire, as outlined in BS 7671. Installation Best Practices Brackets should be installed level and securely anchored to walls, ceilings, or floors. Use non-metallic banding for bundling trays to avoid corrosion or contamination of stainless steel products. Ensure electrical continuity if the tray serves as a grounding path.
