Support Spacing: Maximum support spacing depends on tray type and load; for ladder trays, typical spacing ranges from 3 to 3.6 meters, with a maximum load per hanger around 318–340 kg.

Cable Handling and Safety

- Maintain the minimum bend radius for cables when transitioning vertically to prevent damage.
- Use hold-down clamps or covers to secure cables in vertical sections and prevent slippage.
- Ensure that the tray is balanced and properly fastened to withstand forces generated by cable weight and potential short-circuit events.
- Avoid using the tray as a support for personnel or lifting equipment, as this can damage the system and compromise safety.

Fittings and Accessories

- Vertical Bends (Risers):** Standard fittings allow smooth upward transitions without exceeding cable bend limits.
- Reducers:** Used when connecting trays of different widths in vertical runs.
- Drop-Outs:** Allow cables to exit vertically to equipment below while maintaining support.
