Cantilever wall brackets for vertical or wall-mounted runs. Support spacing typically ranges from 1.5 to 2 meters for standard trays, with adjustments for heavy loads or long spans. Provide additional support at bends, tees, and offsets to prevent sagging and maintain cable integrity. Cable Routing and Installation Pulling cables: Start with heavier power cables, followed by lighter control or data cables. Use rollers, sheaves, and lubricants to minimize jacket damage. Bend radius: Maintain the minimum permissible radius for the largest cable to prevent stress and insulation damage. Cable ties and separation: Secure cables every few meters without over-tightening. Use dividers to separate power and data cables to prevent EMI. Cable fill: Do not exceed 40% for power cables and 50% for control/data cables of the tray cross-sectional area. Calculate fill using NEC 392.22 guidelines. Grounding and Bonding Metallic trays must be electrically continuous and bonded at all joints using...
