Other fasteners, like mushroom head bolts (FLM 6X12/FLM 6X16 F), are used to secure the tray to brackets or struts, providing a stable connection while allowing for adjustments during or after installation. Installation Considerations Load Capacity: Threaded rod hangers typically support loads ranging from 318 kg (700 lbs) to 340 kg (750 lbs) per hanger, with maximum support spacing around 3.6 meters. Retrofit Applications: Push-install nuts and clips allow for easy retrofitting of cable trays without removing existing hardware.
