 - Clamps or Quick-Connect Systems:** These can snap, slide, or twist into place for faster installation, often requiring fewer tools, but may be brand-specific.
- 4. Secure Fastening:** Use bolts, spanners, or torque wrenches to tighten connections. Ensure the tray and box are firmly held to prevent sagging or movement, which could damage cables or compromise grounding.
- 5. Grounding and Bonding:** Metal trays and junction boxes should be properly grounded to prevent electrical hazards. Ensure continuity between the tray and box using bonding jumpers or grounding lugs as required by electrical codes.
- 6. Final Inspection:** Check that all cables are properly supported, splices are protected, and the junction box cover is accessible for future maintenance. Verify that the connection meets local electrical codes and safety standards.
