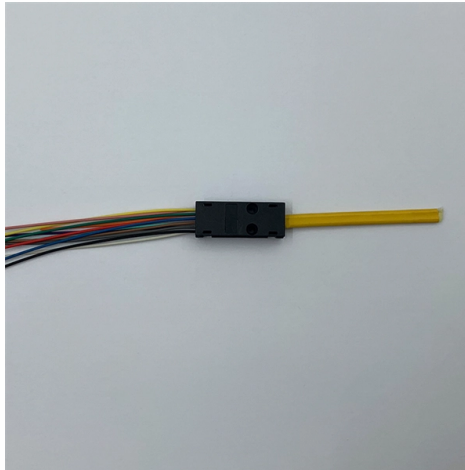

Use threaded rods, metal plugs, and 'L' angles or slotted channels to secure trays. Ensure supports maintain proper clearance for cable pulling and future maintenance.

Cable Laying Lay cables neatly within the tray, separating by voltage and function. Maintain minimum bend radius at tray exits and avoid kinks. Use cable ties or straps to organize cables, leaving slack for expansion or adjustments. For concealed installations, ensure cables are fully enclosed and protected from mechanical damage, heat buildup, or electromagnetic interference.

Sizing and Spacing Calculate tray width and depth based on the number and type of cables. Undersized trays can cause overheating, while oversized trays waste space. Maintain proper rung spacing (typically 150–230 mm) for ladder trays to support cables effectively.
