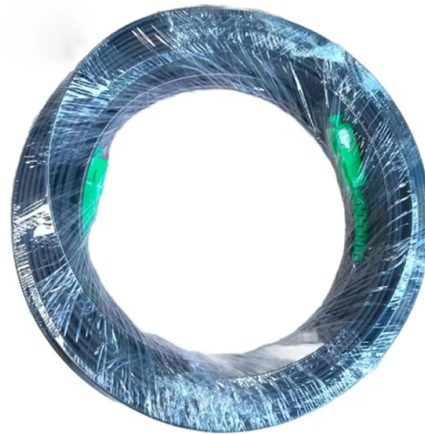


Can single-mode fiber be scaled up using lc
