- Full-body harnesses and karabiners:** Ensure safety and secure attachment to ropes.
- Ropes:** High-strength static or dynamic ropes suitable for vertical operations.
- Communication tools:** Walkie-talkies or megaphones for coordination.

Ascending steps typically involve standing on a foot ascender, sitting back gently in the harness, and repeating until reaching the target height. Descending steps involve attaching a descender to the harness, positioning the body for balance, and gradually releasing the rope to control the descent. Safety measures include wearing proper PPE, checking anchor points, inspecting ropes, and maintaining clear communication.

Rope Techniques and Knots For controlled climbing and descending, climbers use specific knots and rope techniques:

- Slide and Grip Knot:** Controls rappelling and ascent.
- Figure-8 Knot:** Common for secure loops and rope attachment.
- Bowline and Overhand Knots:** Used for safety and joining ropes.
