

Colombia's First Long-Distance Fiber Optic Communication Line



Overview

CSN-1, developed by Telconet in collaboration with Alcatel Submarine Networks, is a high-capacity fiber optic system that connects the west coast of Florida (USA) with Panama, Ecuador, and Colombia, through a route of approximately 4,500km (2,796 miles). Gutta-percha, the adhesive juice of the Palaquium gutta tree, was introduced to Europe by William Montgomerie, a Scottish surgeon in the service of the British East India Company.
