How to Identify Fibers in High-Count Cables (>12 Fibers) For cables with more than 12 strands (e., 48, 96, or 144 fibers), the industry uses a “Tube and Fiber” system. Hexatronic offers cables with color code systems according to all international and national standards and for all types of fiber optic such as a tube, ribbon, yarn wrapped bundle or other types of bundle. This identification scheme follows the TIA/EIA-598, “Optical Fiber Cable Color Coding.
