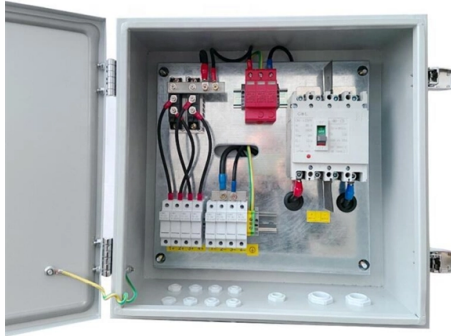


Color of the operation light in the distribution box



Overview

A Step-by-Step Guide to Reading Power Status via the Four-Color Lights in Civil Distribution Boxes Check the box's label first. If not, use this standard: Red: Fault/alarm. Steady = major fault (short circuit/overload); blinking = minor (loose connection). IEC does not mandate a single required color for distribution panel indicator lights, but standards provide guidance through EN 60204-1:2018 (Safety of machinery - Electrical equipment) and IEC 60417 (Graphical symbols for use on equipment). Green is universally associated with safety, nature, growth, and the "go" signal of traffic lights. Meaning: A green light means the motor is running, the process is active, and the operation is normal. Danger or alarm, abnormal condition requiring immediate attention. Indication that a protective device has stopped the machine, e. (the color RED for the emergency stop.

What Do The Different Colors Of The Indicator Light Mean?

The main reason is that the power supply voltage is insufficient, or the voltage level of the indicator light is selected incorrectly, and the brightness of the indicator light cannot be supported.
