- Units must have rounded edges and smooth surfaces for safety and compliance.
- Splice plates, bolts, nuts, and washers are required for connecting sections.
- Covers for steel trays must be hot-dip galvanized; mill galvanized covers are not acceptable for hot-dip trays.
- Fittings include bends, tees, elbows, drop-outs, and supports to accommodate routing.
