- Materials and Protection:** Distribution boxes are typically made from high-impact ABS+PC or metal, offering durability, corrosion resistance, and protection against high temperatures, dust, and water (IP55 or higher). Outdoor models are designed to withstand harsh environmental conditions, while indoor models are compact and wall-mountable for space efficiency.
