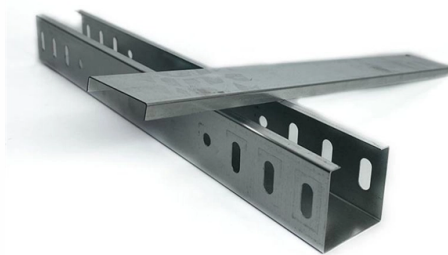


Communication Tower Maintenance Guidelines
