Mount supports securely: Drill inserts or use approved anchors in concrete or tunnel walls. Consult structural engineers before drilling pre-stressed concrete.

Install horizontal supports: Precut rods or struts can be used to maintain alignment. Ensure threaded rods are not damaged during cutting.

Tray Installation Place cable trays onto the installed supports, ensuring continuous alignment and level runs. Connect tray sections using manufacturer-approved fittings to maintain structural integrity and electrical continuity. Avoid using trays as walkways.
