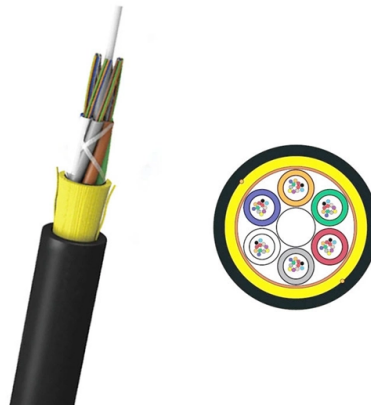


Components of a Network Communication Cabinet
