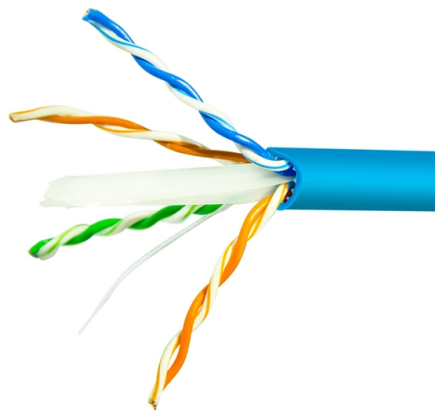


# Connect a network cable to fiber optic transceiver and then a splitter

**Step 3: Insert the Fiber Optic Transceiver** Insert a compatible SFP or SFP+ transceiver into the media converter or switch port .Ensure the transceiver matches the fiber type and speed of your network.

**Step 4: Connect Fiber to the Splitter** Use a fiber patch cable to connect the transceiver's fiber port to the input port of the splitter .Make sure the TX (transmit) and RX (receive) paths are correctly aligned; reversing them will prevent communication .Connect the splitter outputs to the intended fiber endpoints using additional fiber patch cables.

**Step 5: Verify the Connection** Check that all devices show active link lights. Ensure fiber cables are not bent beyond manufacturer specifications to avoid signal loss .If using multiple media converters, confirm that both ends are compatible and properly paired for long-distance connections .

**Best Practices** Always insert the transceiver before connecting the fiber cable and remove the fiber before...
