

Connect two switches to optical fiber

Distance Considerations: Ensure the fiber and SFP modules support the distance between switches. For example, multimode fiber with SX modules typically supports up to 550 meters, while single-mode can reach several kilometers.

Port Configuration: Use the uplink or dedicated fiber ports on each switch. Ensure the port speed and duplex settings match on both ends to avoid connectivity issues.

Step-by-Step Connection

Install SFP Modules: Insert the SFP modules into the fiber ports of each switch.

Select Fiber Cable: Use a duplex LC-to-LC fiber patch cable compatible with the SFP modules (single-mode or multimode as required).

Connect the Fiber: Plug one end of the fiber cable into the SFP module on the first switch and the other end into the second switch.

Verify Link: Check the switch LEDs or management interface to confirm the fiber link is active.

Optional Aggregation: For higher bandwidth, multiple fiber links can be combined using EtherChannel or link aggregation.

Star Topology: Each switch connects to a central switch or core, ideal for minimizing collisions and simplifying management
