If using a fiber optic spectrometer or optical power meter, connect it to one side to verify signal strength and alignment.

**Step 3: Configure the Switch** Set the operating mode using the front-panel switches (e.g., High/Low or Left/Right channel) according to your network requirements. Adjust the optics by loosening the locking screw, moving the SMA connector to optimize alignment, and then tightening the screw. Ensure the switch is powered and that all ports are active.

**Step 4: Verify Connectivity** Test the connection using a network device or optical power meter to confirm proper signal transmission. Check for low insertion loss and minimal signal degradation, which is critical for maintaining network performance. If cascading multiple switches, ensure wavelengths, optical p...
