- One machine, one switch, one protection:** Each device is controlled by a dedicated switch and protected individually.
- Two-level leakage protection:** Leakage protectors are installed both in the primary box and in downstream secondary or tertiary boxes to prevent electrical hazards.

Compliance with construction standards: Designed according to construction electricity regulations to ensure safe operation on temporary sites.
