- Accessibility:** Features front-opening doors and separate covers for fuses and meters, allowing safe maintenance without exposing live components.
- Connection Points:** Includes copper busbars for main connections and multiple outlets for branch circuits.

Installation Guidelines

- Placement:** Should be located within 30 meters of the equipment it serves to minimize voltage drop and ensure efficient distribution.
- Mounting:** Can be wall-mounted or installed on a support frame, depending on site layout and mobility requirements.
- Integration:** Works in conjunction with primary and tertiary distribution boxes, forming a hierarchical network that follows the principle of “one machine, one switch, one RCD, one box, one lock” to prevent multiple devices from being controlled by a single switch.
