Core Switches A core switch is a high-capacity, high-performance Layer 3 switch positioned at the backbone of an enterprise network. Its primary role is to aggregate traffic from distribution switches and ensure ultra-low latency and maximum throughput across the network. Core switches are optimized for speed, reliability, and scalability, often featuring modular chassis, hot-swappable modules, dual power supplies, and support for advanced routing protocols. They handle massive volumes of data without performing resource-intensive tasks like deep packet inspection, focusing instead on rapid packet forwarding. Core switches are typically deployed in large enterprises, campuses, and data centers, where high bandwidth and mission-critical uptime are essential. They serve as the central nervous system of the network, connecting distribution and access layers, and enabling efficient communication between VLANs, subnets, and security zones.

Routers Routers are network devices that connect different networks, such as a local area network (LAN) to a wide area network (WAN) or the internet. Unlike core switches, which primarily operate within a single network, routers determine the optimal path for data packets between networks using routing tables and protocols like OSPF, BGP, or EIGRP. Routers also provide network address translation (NAT), firewall functions, and traffic segmentation, making them essential for external connectivity and security.
