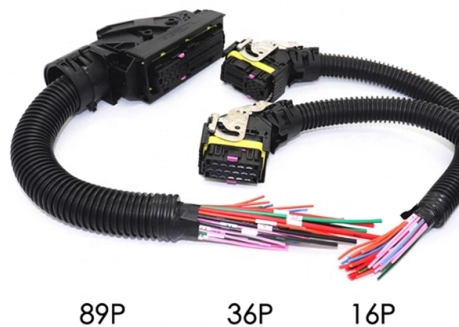


Covering the network cable in the home s electrical distribution box

- Cord covers or sleeves:** Flexible PVC or nylon sleeves provide a tight fit and a clean appearance while safeguarding cables (Index).
- Adhesive cable clips:** Secure cables along the interior walls of the distribution box to prevent tangling and maintain separation from electrical wiring (Index).

Safety Considerations Ensure all cables are properly insulated and undamaged before installation (Index). Maintain separation between network cables and high-voltage electrical wiring to reduce interference and fire risk. Avoid overfilling the enclosure; leave space for airflow to prevent overheating. Periodically inspect the cables and covers for wear, cracks, or loose connections, and replace any damaged...
