High-Density Solutions Adopt high-density fiber panels, cassettes, and enclosures to maximize space and reduce congestion. Modular solutions allow for easy scalability and support rapid deployment of 10-400 GbE links . 3. Cable Routing and Length Optimization Plan precise cable lengths to avoid excess slack and tangling. Use pre-terminated or custom-length cables to maintain clean routing and proper bend radius protection, which preserves signal integrity and simplifies maintenance . 4. Labeling and Documentation Label all cables and ports clearly, and document the cabling infrastructure using CAD or DCIM tools. This enables quick identification of connections, reduces mean time to repair (MTTR), and supports future upgrades . 5. Airflow and Cooling Considerations Ensure cables do not obstruct airflow within racks or overhead pathways.
