

Denmark's Energy Internet Policy Framework



AI Overview

Denmark's Energy Internet Policy focuses on a smart, flexible electricity grid that integrates renewable energy, ensures high security of supply, and supports sector-wide digitalization. Legal and Regulatory Framework The Danish Electricity Supply Act (Elforsyningsloven), updated in 2024, strengthens electricity supply security and defines responsibilities for producers and grid operators, including capacity management and monitoring. Regulations for grid connection, updated in 2023, set technical requirements and tariffs for all energy producers, ensuring fair access and supporting renewable energy expansion. Denmark also aligns its energy laws with EU regulations to enhance cross-border cooperation and market integration.

Renewable Energy and Climate Goals Denmark aims for 100% renewable energy by 2028 and climate neutrality by 2050, with a 70% reduction in greenhouse gas emissions by 2030 compared to 1990 levels. Policies such as the Law on the Promotion of Renewables encourage market-based, technology-neutral support for renewable energy, phasing out technology-specific subsidies. The Climate Agreement - Denmark Can Do More II guides long-term energy strategy, emphasizing offshore wind and solar power expansion.
