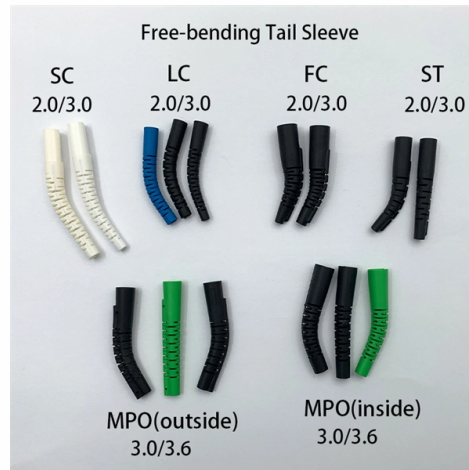

Sheath: The outer sheath is commonly LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen) for indoor use or PVC/LSZH for outdoor aerial cables, contributing 0.5–1 mm to the total thickness.

Fiber Placement and Bend Radius The optical fiber sits centrally within the cable, often in a loose tube or tight-buffered configuration. Bend-insensitive fibers (ITU-T G.657 standard) are used to tolerate minimum bend radii of 10 mm (A1 type), with A2 or B3 variants for tighter conduit bends.
