

Dimensions of cabinets for supercomputing centers

Standard supercomputing center cabinets are typically 19-inch racks, 42U-52U tall, 600-800 mm wide, and 1000-1200 mm deep, designed for high-density server and networking equipment.

Standard Cabinet Dimensions

Width: Most cabinets follow the 19-inch EIA-310 standard, meaning the front panel of mounted equipment is 19 inches (482.6 mm) wide. Cabinet widths are typically 600 mm for server racks and 800 mm for communications racks to accommodate higher cabling density and airflow management.

Height: Cabinet height is expressed in rack units (U), where 1U = 44.45 mm (1.75 inches). Common heights are 42U ($\approx 2,000$ mm), 45U ($\approx 2,100$ mm), and 48U ($\approx 2,300$ mm), with some data centers using up to 52U.

Depth: Depth ranges from 1000 mm to 1200 mm, allowing for deep servers, storage units, and proper cable management.

Load and Structural Considerations

Static load capacity: Typically 1000-1500 kg when fixed to the floor.

Dynamic load capacity: Around 60-70% of static load when moving on casters during installation.

Seismic and safety: Cabinets may require seismic bracing in quake-prone areas, designed by licensed structural engineers.

Cooling and Airflow

Cabinets are designed for front-to-back airflow, often with perforated doors and optional airflow management kits including blanking panels and brush grommets to prevent recirculation.

High-density racks (over 10 kW per rack) may use in-row or rear-door cooling systems to maintain optimal temperatures.

Cable Management and Accessories

Cabinets include cable ingress ports, PDUs, and adjustable rails to support dense cabling and power distribution. Proper grounding and bonding are essential, with low-resistance connections across doors, side panels, and accessories.
