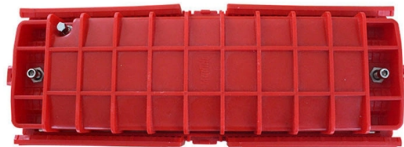

Faulty or Aging Breakers: Breakers lose sensitivity over time, leading to frequent or unpredictable tripping. Types of Tripping Devices Standard Circuit Breakers: Protect against overloads and short circuits in residential or commercial systems. Leakage Protectors (RCCB/GFCI): Detect current leakage to ground and trip to prevent electric shock. Battery Tripping Units (BTUs): Used in industrial DC systems to trip breakers remotely when a fault is detected, ensuring rapid disconnection before equipment failure.
