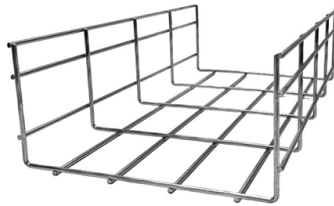


Double row of cable tray joint support

- Alignment and Stiffening:** To maintain proper alignment, spacers or stiffening elements may be required between the two rows. For ceiling-mounted trays, additional threaded rod suspensions or C-profile rails can be used to stabilize the double row and prevent lateral movement ().
- Best Practices:** Avoid cutting or drilling structural members without approval. Use components designed and tested together to ensure safety. Check deflection limits for each tray section to ensure compliance with standards like DIN EN 61537 or BS EN 61537 (). Consider future cable additions when designing support spacing and joint connections.
