Components and Wiring A distribution box typically contains a main switch or breaker, individual circuit breakers, neutral and ground bars, and bus bars. The main switch controls the entire electrical supply, while circuit breakers protect individual circuits from overloads or short circuits. Proper wiring according to IEC color codes is essential: for example, green or green/yellow wires are used for protective earth (PE) in both single-phase and three-phase systems. Installation and Safety Distribution boxes must be installed in areas free from water, excessive dust, and other adverse conditions. Adequate clearance around the panel is required for safe operation and maintenance. Switchgear should be enclosed or rated for outdoor use if installed outside, and metallic boards must have double insulation and covers for live parts. Following these codes ensures co...
