- 5. Sheathing and Jacketing Lines** Sheathing lines apply the outer protective layer, typically made of PVC, LSZH, or PE. These lines ensure smooth, uniform jackets that protect the fibers from moisture, mechanical stress, and environmental hazards.
- 6. Quality Control and Testing Equipment** Throughout the production process, quality control systems monitor fiber length, diameter, and optical performance.
