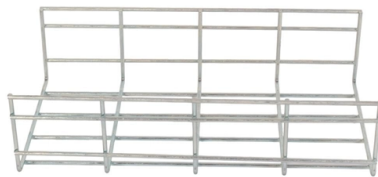


Fiber Optic Cable Joint Box in Cable Trench
