Route the Jumper Properly Follow proper routing paths in racks or fiber trays to avoid sharp bends; maintain a minimum bend radius (typically >400mm). Avoid crossing, tangling, or hanging jumpers outside designated trays. Wrap excess fiber neatly in loops on the tray and secure with bundling tape.

Connect the Jumper Insert one end into the device port or optical transceiver module and the other end into the corresponding port on the network component or ODF rack. Ensure connectors are fully seated and latched according to the connector type (e.g., LC latch, SC plug lock, ST screw fastener).

Verify Activation Once connected, test the link for signal integrity using an optical power meter or network testing tool. Confirm low insertion loss and high return loss to ensure reliable data transmission.
