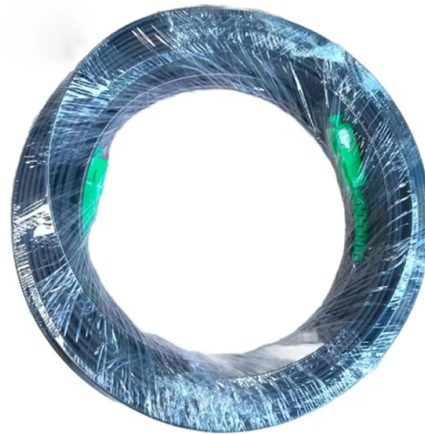

Key cleaning steps include:Inspect connectors with a fiber microscope before mating.Use optical-grade lint-free swabs and cleaning solutions like 99% isopropyl alcohol to clean end faces.Avoid touching fiber ends or bending cables excessively.Use canned or filtered compressed air to remove dust and debris.Follow a wet wipe followed by a dry wipe to ensure no residue remains .Always wear powder-free gloves to prevent contamination .Preventive MaintenancePreventive maintenance ensures long-term reliability:Maintain minimum bend radius and avoid twisting, pinching, or excessive pulling during installation and handling .Protect connectors from contamination and scratches at all times.Regularly clean transceivers and bulkheads to prevent cross-contamination .Use condition-based maintenance rather than fixed schedules, evaluating performance, usage frequency, and environmental exposure .Safety PrecautionsNever look directly into an active fiber optic interface; laser radiation ca...
