

Fiber Optic Cable Line Steel Strand

Fiber optic cables are commonly supported by a steel messenger strand, which bears the cable's weight and is secured using stainless steel lashing wire. Steel Messenger Strand A steel messenger strand is a stranded steel cable designed to support aerial fiber optic cables. It typically consists of six wires wrapped around a central wire, often made of carbon steel with a zinc or zinc-aluminum coating to prevent corrosion, even at cut ends. Coating classes (A, B, C) indicate the thickness of the protective layer, with zinc-aluminum coatings providing higher corrosion resistance for harsh environments such as coastal areas. Messenger strands are specified by diameter and tensile strength to ensure they can safely support the cable and withstand environmental loads like wind, ice, and snow. Lashing Fiber to the Messenger Lashing wire is used to attach the fiber optic cable to the messenger strand. This wire is usually stainless steel, 0.038" to 0.045" in diameter, annealed for ductility, and rated for 70-90 kpsi minimum strength. The lashing process involves wrapping the wire around the messenger and cable in a helical pattern, securing the cable while allowing for some movement to reduce stress on the fibers. Proper tensioning of both the messenger and the lashed cable is critical to maintain safe sag and prevent overloading the cable's tensile limits. Installation Considerations Cable Types: Figure-8 cables integrate the messenger and fiber into a single jacket, simplifying installation, while All-Dielectric Self-Supporting (ADSS) cables do not require a separate messenger. Tensioning: The messenger strand must be tensioned to handle the cable weight plus environmental loads, keeping sag within safe limits. Corrosion Protection: Zinc or zinc-aluminum coatings on the steel strand prevent rust, extending the lifespan of the aerial installation. Permits and Planning: Aerial deployment requires route surveys, pole readiness, and local permits, especially if lashed to existing infrastructure. Bending Radius: Fiber cables must not be bent below their minimum...
