Coatings like zinc, zinc-aluminum alloy (Bezinal®), or other corrosion-resistant layers enhance durability in harsh environments, preventing rust, sagging, or breakage under ice and wind loads. The fiber cable is then lashed to the messenger wire using specialized tools, with tension and slack carefully controlled to maintain ground clearance and line stability. Steel Wire Processing and Coating Steel wires used in fiber optic cables undergo drawing, coating, and galvanization to achieve the required mechanical properties and corrosion resistance. Coatings vary in thickness and composition depending on environmental conditions: Class C zinc coatings are used for high-corrosion areas, while Bezinal® coatings provide superior longevity, lasting two to six times longer than standard galvanization. The steel core enhances tensile strength, allowing the cable to withstand installation stresses and long-term environmental exposure.
