Design and Components

Ferrule: The fiber end is embedded in a 2.5 mm ferrule, typically made of zirconia ceramic or stainless steel, which provides precise alignment of the fiber cores .

Polish Types: The ferrule tip is polished to create a physical contact (PC) surface. Variants include FC/PC, FC/SPC (super PC), and FC/UPC (ultra PC), with higher polish grades offering lower insertion loss and reduced back-reflection .

Threaded Coupling: The connector screws into the receptacle, preventing rotation and ensuring stable mating. A spring mechanism controls the contact force between fibers .

Keying: A key prevents fiber rotation during mating, which is critical for polarization-maintaining fibers .
